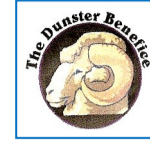

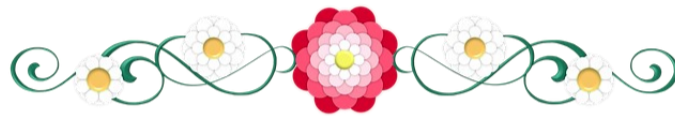

Daniel 7.9-10, 13-14

As I watched,
