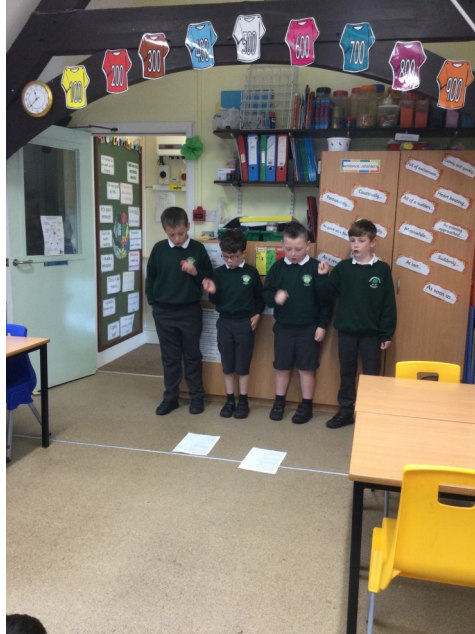
News from Class Two

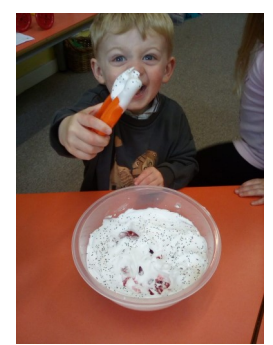
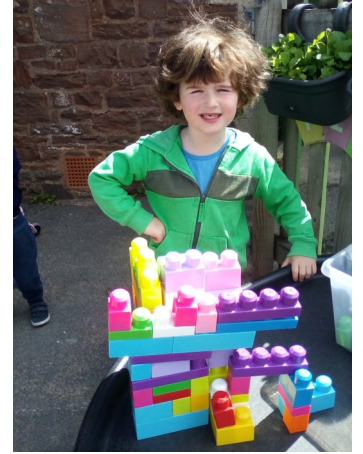


Little Oaks News

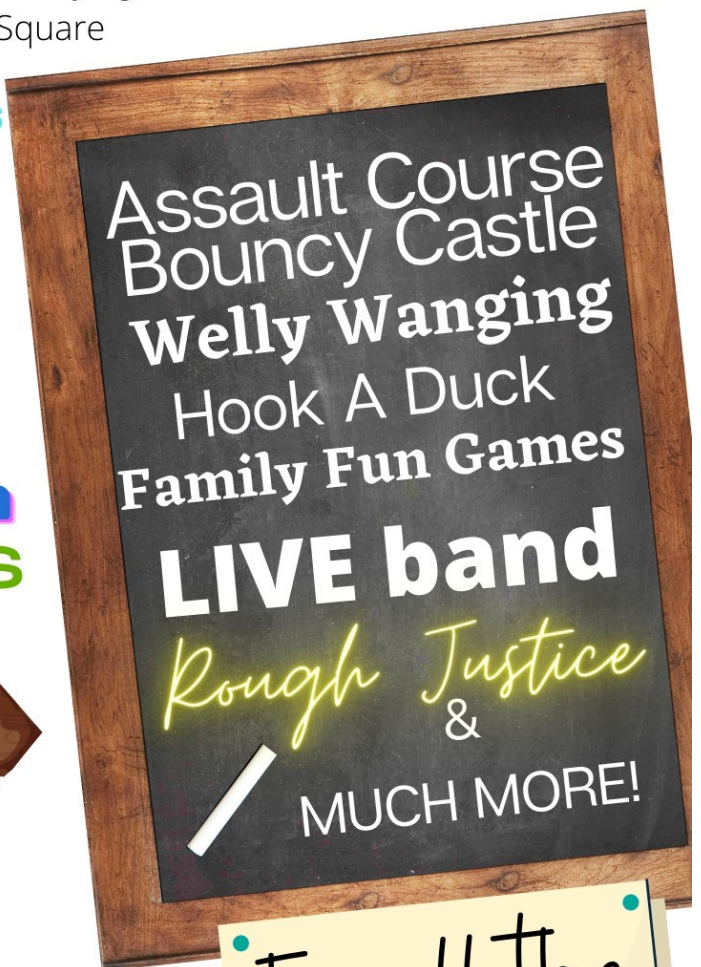
