To leave a share of your estate (Residuary Bequest)

This is the gift of all or part of the value of your estate (after debts, other legacies and liabilities have been met). This has the advantage of automatically keeping up with inflation.

To leave a fixed sum of money (Pecuniary Bequest)

You can choose to leave a fixed sum of money, which you can arrange with your solicitor to be increased in line with inflation.

The suggested wording for a bequest is:

purposes, and I declare that the receipt of an officer of the Parochial Church Council shall be a sufficient

Changing your Will If you have already made your Will and wish to change any part of it, you need to add a codicil: a form that is added into your Will and reflects any changes to your circumstances. This Codicil form is available online or from Marion Moncrieff, PCC Treasurer.
