Around this time of year, I know your thoughts turn to the village website and how it has performed during 2022. Well, wonder no more - here is a roundup which explains all you could want to know.


### BUSIEST MONTH

March 2022 was the busiest month on the website. The cause was a post about Clicket, a small valley and settlement near Timberscombe.




### ANNUAL COMPARISON

Overall, the site saw a small increase on 2021 with nearly 9,000 people visiting the site, viewing over 26,000 pages.

## THE EMAIL LIST

The email list contains 184 people who are active subscribers. 75% of these are judged to 'often' open the emails. They appear to be located in Timberscombe, Minehead, Amsterdam (err why?) and Watchet.

The village email list is run by Mailchimp, and we qualify for a free account until we reach 2,000 subscribers - something which is unlikely to happen.

## SUMMARY

Hosting the site is funded by the Parish Council. We have used 27% of the storage capacity of the website since its inauguration in 2018, which is 1.6 gigabytes out of 6GB on our account. If, in a few years' time, we fill up our storage space, we can always upgrade our plan or have a big electronic tidy-up.
