## GAZA

The shocking and catastrophic situation in Gaza continues. In Northern Gaza, the Al Ahli Hospital, owned and supported by the Episcopal Diocese of Jerusalem, is still serving the whole human 'family' (ahli) despite the most appalling oppression and bombardment. It is now the only functioning hospital in the north, and they are somehow maintaining a 24 hour emergency service.

The Jerusalem and Middle East Church Association has put out an appeal for support to keep the hospital going and, with Fr Kenneth's encouragement, I invite you to help. You could send me a cheque made payable to JMECA and marked Al Ahli on the back, by the end of August, or if you prefer to donate online, go to [jmecca.org.uk](http://jmecca.org.uk) - if you do so online, it would be really helpful to have a note of the donation you've sent so that we can have an idea of how much we raised together.
