Luckily on this occasion, the losses were refunded by the Bank, but it is a reminder that these criminals are experts at impersonating people, organisations and even the Police. They may spend hours researching victims, hoping you will let your guard down. So if you receive a call or a message, stop and think. It could protect your money and stop you becoming a victim. 
It's well worth a visit and may prevent you or someone you pass the information on to becoming a victim of a scam.
